

NATHAN COLEY IN MEMORY: MEMORY TREE



AIMS OF WORKSHOP

To create a group installation of a memory tree on a real tree in the artland or a created tree inside, hanging on to it leaf labels of different memories.

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT

The sculpture In Memory which focuses the viewer on memory and remembrance.

METHOD

Brainstorm on memory and what it means, each child writes a list of memories and then selects a special one, they create a paper leaf which they write the memory on to and then can decorate ready to go outside onto a real tree or be added to a tree created in the classroom.

RESOURCES

Paper, paint, create a tree from decorated branches

Follow up activities would be making a permanent memory or wishing tree for outside or inside at school.
