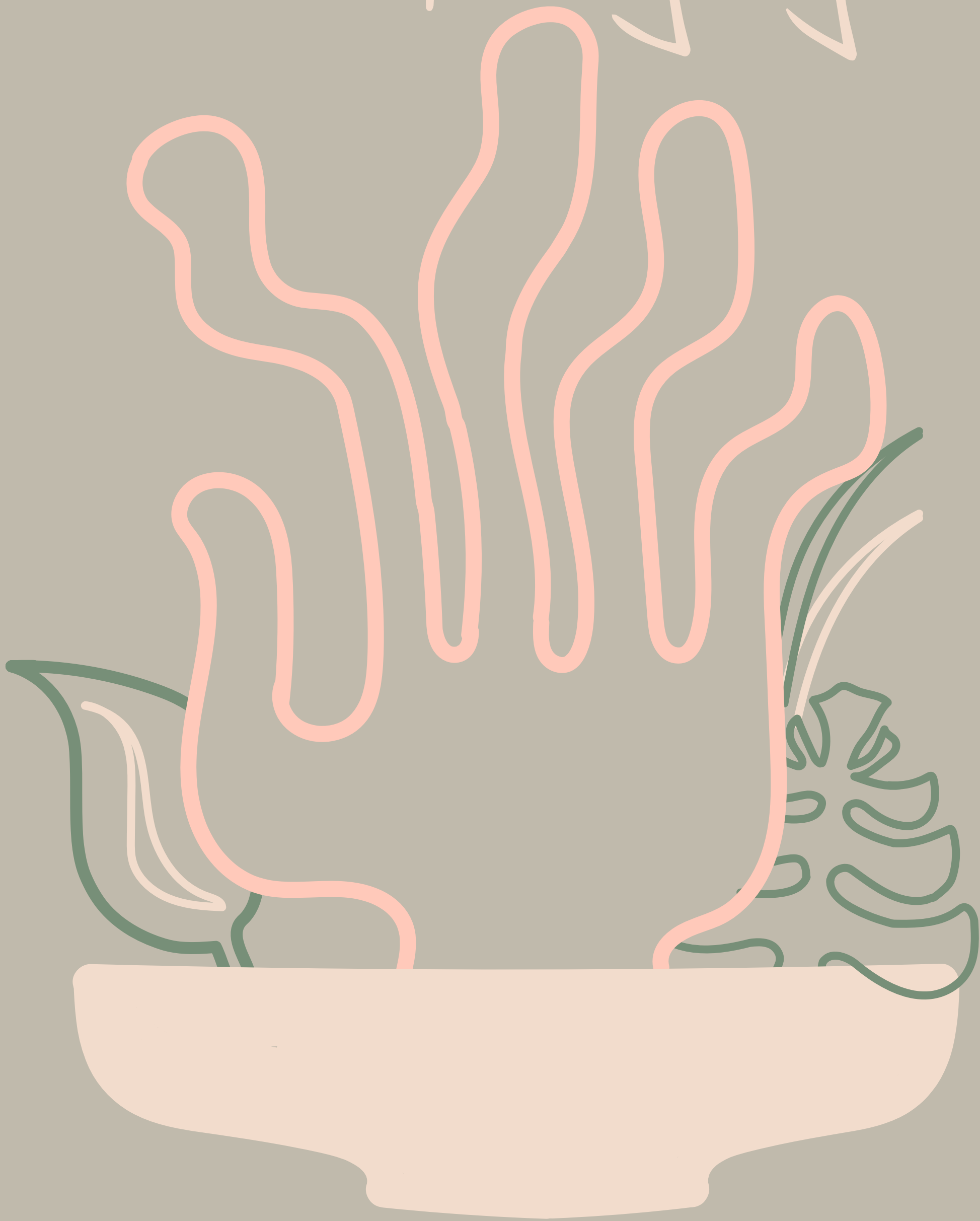


Festive Foraging

YOU WILL NEED:

A dinner plate, a candle (and something to hold it upright),
a selection of foraged goods no bigger than your hand

1. Let's start with a foraging wander. Go for a walk in the places you like to hang out, it could be your dog walk, or where you have a kickabout in the park!
2. You're a diverse type of person, so make sure you collect a range of objects - look for something colourful, something with texture, something large and something tiny
3. Stop when you feel you've got a plate full!
4. Now start arranging your personality plate - which things do you want to place at the front? Which secret messages can you hide at the back? Are you a tidy or chaotic?
5. Light and stand back... Ask a friend to have a look at your plate, can they tell what you have tried to express about yourself?
